Preparation Guidelines for General Pest Treatment

- Have toys, clothes, etc. picked up in rooms. Furniture we can usually spray behind or under, so make sure no items are in those areas.
- Remove items from window sills. We may need to treat around them for spiders or ants.
- Best to have air currents off during treatment. Furnace, A/C, fans, etc.
- Put away or cover up open or exposed food items.
- Have kitchen and bathroom counters cleaned off if we need to treat for roaches or ants.
- Have animal food and water covered and away from wall.
- It's best to have children and pets out of the home while we treat. They are curious and tend to want to follow us "too close" sometimes, and may limit our ability to do a thorough job or inspection. Best to have them out of the house for an hour or more after as well to give the products time to dry.
- We normally won't spray bedroom closets, but if you would like them sprayed, please have shoes and items off the floor and door open.
- Don't do any spraying or dusting of over-the-counter products before we arrive, or after we leave. If already done, please clean the residue before we come. They can damage the effects of our products.
- Don't forget the outside! If we are doing an outside perimeter treatment, please have toys, pet food, laundry, and anything else away from the perimeter you don't want any possible overspray on.

If you will not be there when we treat, please leave a note of any rooms or areas needing special attention.
